RULES AND REGULATIONS


- **Regular Season:** from the opening day of Pennsylvania Trout Season until Labor Day.
- **Extended Season:** from the day after Labor Day until the third Monday in February.
- A Pennsylvania Fishing License and a Trout Stamp is required.
- The Stretch is owned and operated by Blue Ridge Real Estate Company. Blue Ridge fishing regulations are more stringent than the Pennsylvania Fish Commission regulations. Blue Ridge regulations always apply.
- **A sign-in box is located at the entrance of The Stretch. All members and guests are required to sign in and out each time they visit.**
- **Guests are also required to sign a liability release before fishing. Releases are located in the sign-in box at the entrance.**
- Only artificial flies, nymphs and streamers are permitted. Use of other lures commonly described as spinners, spoons or plugs is prohibited. No live bait.
- Possession of any bait or lures other than flies, nymphs and streamers are prohibited while fishing The Stretch.
- Fishing may be done only with conventional fly-fishing tackle. No spinning rods allowed.
- All trout taken must be at least seven (7) inches in length.
- The daily limit is five (5) fish and must be included in the legal daily limit of all fish taken from other streams in accordance with state laws. The daily limit during the Extended Season will be three (3) trout.
- Members are allowed to fish as many times as they wish during the same week.
- The weekly limit is ten (10) fish.
- **An individual may fish The Stretch as a guest 3 days during the season and must be accompanied by and fish in the same pool as their sponsor. No guests are allowed on Opening Day.**
- Please move to another pool after taking two (2) fish.
- Indiscriminate wading through the pools is prohibited. Stay as close to shore as possible.
- Entering a pool while another fisherman is in it is prohibited. Please wait until he/she is finished before entering the pool.
- Fishing begins one half hour before sunrise. Fishing ends so members and guests are out of the water and in a parking area at sunset. Fishing begins at 8:00 a.m. April 4, 2026, the Opening Day of Pennsylvania trout season.
- To keep our stocking report accurate, members and guests are required to report all fish taken each day, using forms provided in sign-in box located at the entrance gate.
- Violation of Stretch rules and regulations may result in the revocation of your membership. Dues will not be refunded.

GENERAL NOTES

- Patrolmen are required to be helpful and cooperate with the participants while seeing that all rules and regulations are observed.
- Patrolmen have the right to inspect creels at any time.
- Blue Ridge reserves the right to cancel fishing privileges at any time upon the failure of a participant or his guests to observe the rules and regulations.
- Complaints should be reported to a patrolman.
- Participants must always display their Identification Badge while fishing.
- A car tag must be displayed on vehicle rear view mirror while in The Stretch.
- The gathering, cutting, digging, removing of any plants including trees, shrubs, vines and flowering plants is prohibited.
- Participants are expected to continue to keep the stream, grounds and shelters clean and free of trash.

GUEST FEES


Regular and Extended
